The candidate will be offered an academic appointment depending on their clinical and academic achievement in the Stritch School of Medicine. Experience with both Robotic and VATS minimally invasive surgery and open surgical approach is desired. Additionally the opportunity to become involved in our busy lung transplant program. The successful candidate will have completed an ACGME-approved program in Thoracic Surgery; achieved or eligible for certification by the American Board of Thoracic Surgery, and have or be eligible for an unrestricted Illinois Medical License. There is also an opportunity for a surgeon to develop an independent practice in Thoracic surgery in a satellite hospital and will suit a Board Certified surgeon, 3-5 years after Fellowship training.
